

REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION FOR A FIREARM CERTIFICATE APPLICATION, FOR THE VARIOUS CLASSES OF LICENCE

HOME PROTECTION

1. Completed FR1 form, signed and stamped by the member-in-charge of your local police station.
2. If being acquired from an individual, the seller's firearm certificate and an agreement of sale in affidavit form, certified by a commissioner of oaths, together with a copy of the seller's ID card.
3. If being acquired from a firearm dealer, a completed FR11 form.
4. Two sets of vetted fingerprints.
5. Copy of title deeds or lease agreement.
6. Police letter of gun cabinet inspection.
7. Support letter from Officer Commanding District (DISPOL) for a first application.
8. Support letter from Officer Commanding Province (PROPOL) for a first application.
9. Letter from applicant's doctor stating that the applicant is emotionally stable enough to own a firearm. Must state how long the applicant has been known to the doctor.
10. Certificate of firearm safety training from a registered gun club, or government-registered instructor.
11. 3 colour passport photos.

GUN CLUB SPORT

1. Completed FR1 form, signed and stamped by the member-in-charge of your local police station.
2. If being acquired from a firearm dealer, a completed FR11 form.
3. If being acquired from an individual, the seller's firearm certificate and an agreement of sale in affidavit form, certified by a commissioner of oaths, together with a copy of the seller's ID card.
4. Two sets of vetted fingerprints.
5. Support letter from gun club or certified copy of valid gun club membership card.
6. Police letter of gun cabinet inspection.
7. Support letter from Officer Commanding District (DISPOL) for first application.

HUNTING

1. Completed FR1 form, signed and stamped by the member-in-charge of your local police station.

3. If being acquired from an individual, the seller's firearm certificate and an agreement of sale in affidavit form, certified by a commissioner of oaths, together with a copy of the seller's ID card.
4. Two sets of vetted fingerprints.
5. Support letter from the National Parks and Wildlife Management Authority, and a certified copy of applicant's professional hunter's or professional guide's licence if applicable. (National Parks may require a letter from a landowner/authority with an established hunting quota.)

7. Support letter from Officer Commanding District (DISPOL) for first application.
8. Support letter from Officer Commanding Province (PROPOL) for first application.
9. Letter from applicant's doctor stating that the applicant is emotionally stable enough to own a firearm. Must state how long the applicant has been known to the doctor.

11. 3 colour passport photographs.

PROTECTION OF CROPS AND LIVESTOCK

1. Completed FR1 form, signed and stamped by the member-in-charge of your local police station.

5. Support letter from either Agritex, the District Administrator, the Local Authority and the National Parks and Wildlife Management Authority.

5. Valid Security Guard's licence.
6. Certificate of Incorporation.
7. Valid CR 14.
8. Letter of appointment on company letterhead.
9. Police letter of gun cabinet inspection.
10. Support letter from Officer Commanding District (DISPOL) for first application.
